

Animal Reiki Treatment Consent Form

Please read the following statements carefully and sign to give your consent for your pet/animal to receive reiki treatments. Any questions, please do not hesitate to ask the practitioner prior to the treatment.

The Reiki Treatment

Reiki treatments may take up to an hour; this includes an initial assessment and discussion of outcomes. Depending on these outcomes further treatments may be suggested, to be discussed after the treatment. The cost per treatment is £35. Payment plans can be discussed for further sessions if necessary.

During the treatment the animal will be given the opportunity to lie down, sit or move around. Depending on the animal and premises, it may be required for the animal to be secured in a suitable holding cage or crate for the treatments. There may be the opportunity for the animal to be removed from the enclosure to receive hands on reiki should it be safe to do so, although reiki will still work without hands on so it is not essential. There will be access to blankets, heat mats and cushions if necessary to provide warmth and comfort. The animal will have access to water also.

Reiki often requires that hands are positioned on the body, if there is a reason this method cannot be performed on the animal please inform the practitioner prior to the treatment.

The treatment may cause the animal to move around more as they adjust to the energy fluctuations, it may feel strange to them at first or they may refuse the treatment all together. Often they will find a comfortable position and allow the treatment to proceed until they have had enough. The treatment may trigger heightened emotions, tiredness or increased energy. Above all the animal may feel calm and relaxed with a sense of peace and wellbeing. After the treatment they will be given time to come round and drink some water while the outcomes are discussed.

After the treatment the animal must have access to plenty of water and be given the opportunity to rest.

Practice Statement

- I understand that reiki is intended as a treatment to relieve stress, aid relaxation and correct energy imbalances. It is not a substitute for medical care. I understand that the reiki practitioner cannot diagnose conditions, prescribe medications or advise medical treatment and that any outcomes are not intended as medical diagnosis.
- I understand that I should seek advice from my veterinarian as to whether I should proceed with reiki treatment for my pet/animal before treatments commence.

- I further understand that the treatment may involve hand contact on or above the body. I understand that I must inform the practitioner if the animal may be uncomfortable with hands on reiki or if there is any reason the animal cannot be touched. This applies also if the animal has any aggressive tendencies or may pose a danger to the practitioner.
- I agree to inform the practitioner if personal protective equipment is required due to the risk of injury to the practitioner from an animal and to sufficiently muzzle or restrain an animal if necessary.
- I understand that small mammals, reptiles, aquatic, poultry and avian species must be preliminary contained in a suitable holding enclosure to prevent risk of escape.
- Having read the above statement I would like to request reiki treatment for my pet/animal, I understand the reiki practitioner cannot be held responsible for the outcomes of the treatments.
- I also understand that all sessions are confidential and that my personal details or that of the animal will not be shared without express/written consent.
